▶ 1700 The Iroquois, Shawnee, Lenni
Lenape or Delaware, Seneca-Cayuga,
and Wyandot live in the area now
known as central Ohio.



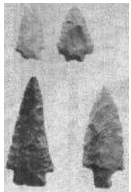
▶ 100 BC-500 AD
